- **When:** Monday, July 17 - Friday July 21; 10 a.m. - 3 p.m.
- **Where:** NC State Campus, Raleigh, N.C.; Butler Communications Building (off of Western Boulevard)
- **Cost:** \$400.00 The cost covers a week (Monday – Friday; 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.) of college-level instruction; camp-hours accident insurance; course materials; use of broadcast-quality studio and equipment; certificate of achievement; a final day reception and newscast screening for campers and parents; and a DVD of campers' newscasts. A **deposit of \$200.00 is due at the time of registration**, with the **\$200.00 balance due May 31, 2017**. *Early-Bird Tuition: save \$25.00 by paying \$375.00 in full by April 12, 2017*
- **How:** Registration opens March 14, 2017. Once we receive the School Verification / Student Recommendation form for your child, a COM Camp administrator will send a registration packet and complete information on payment, camp rules, parking, etc. Registration closes when all 14 spaces are filled. A wait-list is available.
